STUD DOG CLASS – Will be for Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Variety or some other Non-Regular Class. (An entry fee of \$18.00 will be charged if the Stud Dog is entered in one of the regular classes. If not entered in a Regular Class, the entry fee will be \$25.00.

BROOD BITCH CLASS- Will be for Brood Bitches and two of their Produce. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. Owner of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be the owner of the Produce. Produce only to be judged, based on the merits of the Produce. While the merits of the Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the Standard for its breed. Produce must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Variety Competition or some other Non-Regular Class. An entry fee of \$18.00 will be charged if the Brood Bitch is entered in one of the Regular Classes. If not entered in a Regular Class, the entry fee will be \$25.00.

As the Judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of these dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed of Variety by virtue of having won its class
